## **TUITION ASSISTANCE**

ERC is committed to provide support to veterans, service members and military families to focus on their career transition and education goals.

The TA amount authorized per Service member to pay tuition for college courses (part of an evaluated education program) is uniform across the Services at up to \$250.00 per semester hour of credit with a maximum of \$4500.00 for each fiscal year (per DoD Policy).

- Textbooks/supplies provided at no cost.
- Possible transfer credits for your military courses.
- Online support teams and military education coordinators located at base installations around the country.

## TUITION REFUND FOR ALL PROGRAMS

New students have the right to cancel the enrollment agreement including any equipment such as books, materials, and supplies offered in the enrollment agreement, if notice of cancellation is made within seven (7) calendar days (excluding holidays) of enrollment or by the seventh (7th) calendar day following the scheduled program start date, whichever is later. 100% refund of fees and other charges will be made if enrollment cancellation occurs before the start of a program.



## **REFUND POLICY FOR PROGRAMS OBLIGATING STUDENTS FOR PERIODS OF 12 MONTHS OR LESS**

Refunds are calculated based on the payment period the student was attending through his or her last date of attendance when the student dropped.

The refund policy for students attending who incur a financial obligation for a period of 12-months or less shall be as follows:

- Refund amounts must be based on a students' last date of attendance (LDA). During the first week of classes, tuition charges withheld must not exceed 10 percent (10%) of the stated tuition up to a maximum of \$1,000.
- After the first 25% of the period of financial obligation and until the end of the first 60% of the period of obligation the institution shall refund at least 25% of the tuition.
- After the first 60% of the period of financial obligation the institution may retain all of the tuition.

## **REFUND POLICY FOR PROGRAMS OBLIGATING STUDENTS FOR PERIODS BEYOND 12 MONTHS**

Programs longer than 12-months that financially obligate the student for any period of time beyond 12-months shall release the student of the obligation to pay beyond the 12-months if the student withdraws during the first 12-months. The calculation of the refund for the unused portion of the first 12-months shall be based on above mentioned section.

### **REFUND COMPUTATION EXAMPLE**

**(Avocational Programs More than 300 Clock Hours and All Vocational Programs)**

900 Clock Hours of Training Scheduled Start on January 7, Scheduled Completion on August 2. Student is financially obligated for the entire program, 900 Clock Hours of Training Registration Fee is \$75 for non-degree programs, \$100 for the degree program, which is non-refundable.

1 – 30 Hours	100% Return
31 – 229 Hours	75% Return
230 – 454 Hours	50% Return

**20% Return (60% Completion of Course)**

### **RETURN OF MILITARY TUITION ASSISTANCE (TA) POLICY**

If a student receiving Military Tuition Assistance (TA) withdraws from a program, the student may no longer be eligible for the full amount of TA funds originally awarded. To comply with the new Department of Defense Policy, Eagle Rock College will return any unearned TA funds on a prorated basis through at least the 60% portion of the period for which the funds were provided. After 60 percent of the program is completed TA will be deemed fully earned by the institution. Students are responsible for any balances remaining after any TA is refunded to the Department of Defense.
